

HERE'S A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE OF HOW TO MIX & POUR "ART RESINS" 2 PART LIQUID RESIN.

TOOLS & MATERIALS REQUIRED





ALWAYS WEAR VAPOUR MASK & SAFETY GOGGLES.
MAKE SURE YOUR WORKSPACE IS WELL VENTILATED.
TAKE A BREAK OUTSIDE EVERY SO OFTEN.



ADVICE BEFORE YOU CAST

ART RESIN IS A 2 PART SEMI TRANSPARENT LIQUID RESIN. IT'S A 50/50 MIX BETWEEN RESIN AND HARDENER, THIS PRODUCT COMES IN MANY SIZES FROM 80Z TO IO GALLON CONTAINERS. CASTING THIS RESIN TAKES 24 HOURS TO HARDEN.



RESIN MIXING - STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

ART RESIN IS A IS A TWO-PART MIXTURE, PART A IS THE RESIN & PART B IS THE HARDENER. THIS BRAND OF RESIN WORKS ON A 50/50 MIX RATIO.

- LET'S USE 100 GRAMS WEIGHT FOR THIS EXAMPLE.



SET UP AS SHOWN &
ZERO SCALES WITH THE
TARE BUTTON + GRAMS.

POUR PART A RESIN SLOWLY INTO THE PLASTIC CUP. POUR PART B THE
HARDENER OVER THE
TOP OF PART A RESIN.

MIX TOGETHER
WITH A WOODEN
STIRRER.

RESIN POURING - STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE


WE HAVE LOADS OF TIME TO POUR, SO TAKE IT EASY.



POUR THE RESIN INTO THE SILICONE TOOL & FILL THE ENTIRE CAVITY FULL. IF YOU RUN OVER THE TOP OF THE HOLE, USE THE CORNER OF A PAPER TOWEL TO CAREFULLY REMOVE ANY EXCESS RESIN.



THIS RESIN TAKES 24 HOURS TO SET HARD, SO LEAVE IT TO CURE SOMEWHERE DUST FREE.



YOU WILL KNOW WHEN THE
CAST INSIDE THE TOOL IS FULLY
CURED. JUST LOOK AT THE PLASTIC
CUP YOU USED TO MIX THE RESIN IN,
IF YOU SEE THE RESIN IS HARD IN
THE CUP, CHANCES ARE IT'S HARD
IN THE TOOL. TIME TO POP IT OUT.
